Background: Bub1 is a serine-threonine protein kinase and an important regulator of cell division. It is essential for the G2/M mitotic spindle assembly/integrity checkpoint as well as critical for chromosome alignment. Bub1 is required for the assembly of a large number of proteins at the kinetochore, including CENP-E, CENP-F, BUB1B, MAD2L1 and PLK1. It plays a role in sister chromatid cohesion and it serves as a substrate for the anaphase-promoting complex. Bub1 mediates cell death in response to chromosome mis-segregation and acts to suppress spontaneous tumorigenesis.

Immunogen: This Bub1 antibody was raised against a recombinant protein corresponding to amino acids 281-419 of human Bub1.

Buffer: Purified IgG in 70 mM Tris (pH 8), 105 mM NaCl, 31 mM glycine, 0.07 mM EDTA, 30% glycerol and 0.035% sodium azide. Sodium azide is highly toxic.

Application Notes:

Storage and Guarantee: Some products may be shipped at room temperature. This will not affect their stability or performance. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles by aliquoting items into single-use fractions for storage at -20°C for up to 2 years. Keep all reagents on ice when not in storage. This product is guaranteed for 12 months from date of receipt.
